CHAMPIONS SOCCER LEAGUE

SPRING & COPA TOURNAMENTS

- 1. Necessary meetings will be scheduled on the website and the location will be at 324 Chester Ave. Bakersfield, CA.
- 2. Each club or team must present a delegate no more than 2 people at meetings.
- 3. Coach who does NOT pay his fines or fields, is NOT scheduled to play and will forfeit his game.
- 4. To register, new players will be asked for the original record, and a school photo ID, a DMV ID, passport.
- 5. Players who report due to age or cachirulo, said players will have to verify with original birth certificate and identification with a portrait of the sequel, DMV, passport, residence permit or consular registration.
- 6. The maximum number of players that can be registered per team is 16 for minor divisions of U-9, 20 players for Youth divisions of U-10 or higher until U-18 and 22 players for the Free and Veteran divisions.
- 7. For minors from U-6 to U-9 they will have 2 times of 25 min. with 5 min. Rest.
- 8. For minors from U-10 to U-12 they will have 2 times of 35 min. with 10 min. Rest.
- 9. For minors from U-13 to U-16 they will have 2 times of 40 min. with 10 min. Rest.
- 10. Division of U-18, Adults and Veterans will have 2 halves of 45 minutes with 10 minutes of rest. Over-50 veterans have 2 times of 35 minutes 10 rest.
- 11. Ball size U-6 (3) for U-8 and U-9 (4), for U-10 or larger size (5).
- 12. Every team that plays away from the Sports Village has a 15-minute wait. In the case of a coach who has 2 or more teams and they play away on the same field, only the 1st team has a 15-minute wait.
- 13. 5 players can only play in 2 teams from the same club with different credentials from each division.
- 14. There is no time limit to complete the 11 players in a regular match. During the league or finals the team must complete 11 during the first half.

- 15. Players who register in a team and play 2 official matches, can no longer change or register with another team during that same tournament. If a player owes money to the coach, he must pay first in order to play for another team.
- 16. The CSL board of directors has the right to deny services and participation in the league, without being able to attend meetings or direct any game, to coaches, assistants or players who are "negligent", "problematic", "negative" or who owe fines.
- 17. Any coach or member of the board of directors who is sure and sees a team playing cachirul in any game, on any field, at any time, must notify the board of directors. We need your help to eliminate the cachirules.
- 18. The Board of Directors has the right and consent of all members and coaches of the Champions Soccer League to make decisions, penalties and fines.
- 19. The coach who makes the report must notify the referee and the opposing team. You must do it in writing on any piece of paper. If the opposing team wants to defend said report, it must do so in writing, the referee must accept the 2 reports if they are made on the field. Or they can turn it over to the League's board of directors.
- 20. To avoid problems with teams from outside Bakersfield, in the Liguilla and if there field or doubleheader weekday games will be played at the Sports Village.
- 21. In case of an incident or problem that is not in the rules, the board of directors will decide the punishment or fine and it will become part of the rules immediately.
- 22. Each Coach is responsible for paying the cost of the use of the field and referee in advance one week before or each month in advance.

REGISTRATION FEE

- 23. The Youth cost for the Spring or Cup Tournament; \$200 Each player pays his registration \$40.
- 24. Player who registers to play in 2 teams of the same club in the same tournament, for the 1st team he pays regular registration \$40 and for the 2nd team he pays \$25.
- 25. The cost of a transfer from one team to another in the same year pays \$25.
- 26. Cost per tournament for U-18, Free and Veterans division \$250. each player pays \$40.00 for registration and does NOT cover medical insurance.
- 27. All teams are responsible for paying the Tournament one week before the start of each tournament for the use of the field and the referee to a person in charge before their match. Or pay per month in advance.

FINES AND PENALTIES

- 28. A coach who does not pay his fines or fields will not be scheduled for a game and will lose his match, nor will he be able to participate as a coach or player.
- 29. A team that registers a player of legal age or makes a cachirulo will be fined \$250, will lose the points accumulated at that time, the team will play one year as a visitor, and the player will be suspended for the entire season or equivalent to a whole year.
- 30. Coach who owes fines, use of fields or is punished, can not register or direct any team, or under another person. If said coach directly or indirectly manages a team, the team will lose the match 0-5
- 31. Team losing by foul will lose 0-5 and the winner will win 1-0 and the goal will be counted to the winning team's scoring leader or at the discretion of the league.
- 32. Player who accumulates 3 warnings will be suspended one game and a \$5 fine.
- 33. Player who is expelled for a double yellow card will pay \$5 and a suspended game.
- 34. Player who is sent off with a direct red card will be suspended for 2 games and pays \$10.
- 35. Player who is expelled for wanting to fight, assaulting, or disrespecting the referee will have 3 games suspended and will pay a \$15 fine.
- 36. Coach who is expelled for constantly interfering with plays will be punished 3 matches and \$15 fine. For wanting to fight, attack or disrespect the referee, he will be suspended 5 games, he will pay \$25.
- 37. Person who is Coach or Player of one or more teams who is expelled for X reason, may not be present on the field in any match of any division.
- 38. Player or coach who actually hits will be suspended for the entire season or equivalent to one year and the team's coach will pay a \$100 fine.
- 39. Equipment outside the Sports Village that does not paint the field, or is in poor condition will lose the match. If the referee considers that it can be played, or the teams agree and play it, the game counts.
- 40. Each team is responsible for their cheer. If any person is drunk or drinking alcohol or fights, the fine is \$100 and they lose the match.
- 41. Home team has the right to choose the place for its cheer, its uniform and side within the field. Team that does not comply with said rule will be fined \$25.

- 42. If the cheerleader or coach disrespects the referee. The referee must notify the coach 1 time, in the 2nd time the referee can make a report and the responsible team is fined \$50. If the referee stops the game for X reason. The referee must notify the coach that he is going to stop the game and the responsible team if he is winning, he will lose the game, and if he is losing the score counts, or whatever is worse than 0-5.
- 43. Coach or assistant with credential can only direct the team or represent it with the referee.
- 44. A team that does not have a completely filled out card will be fined \$10. And if you do not present an official ID, you will be fined \$15.
- 45. Team that vacates the field and no longer wants to continue playing, if the score is losing, it counts if it is worse than 0-5 and if it is winning, it loses the game 0-5 and pays a \$25 fine.
- 46. Players who swear or are disrespectful during or at the end of the game will be punished for 2 games and a \$10 fine.
- 47. The cheerleader or Coaches who insult players, the referee or the opposing cheerleader during or after the game, will pay a \$25 fine.
- 48. Club teams that play in other leagues can play in our league. Any team that wants to change or cancel their game will pay for the use of the field on the Sunday that they cancel or change. And he will pay for the field for the 2 teams if it is not played on Sunday and the opposing team only if they accept said change.
- 49. Each coach is responsible for dismissing his players who no longer play on his team or who notify him that they no longer want to play on the team. Coach who refuses to drop his players will pay a fine of \$25.
- 50. Team that invades the field with the intention of attacking or causing a fight, by a coach, player, or his team, will be fined \$25, if the referee stops the match, he must notify the coach that he is going to stop the match and will be fined \$50 and loses the game 0-5, and if he is losing worse than 0-5, the score counts. For the safety of the referee they want to attack, they do not have to notify that the game is going to end.
- 51. Coach or cheerleader who threatens any member of the league, coach, umpire or board of directors will be suspended for 1 year, may not play, may not attend meetings or direct any game.
- 52. Teams that cancel their game or do not show up as visitors outside of Bakersfield or vice versa will be fined \$50.
- 53. Teams that do not show up for the inauguration will be fined \$25, league games or finals will be fined \$50, Players who do not show up for the trophy delivery will not receive their trophy or medal.

- 54. A team or coach that allows players to play without a credential or without written permission from the league will be fined \$50.
- 55. Coach or assistant must bring and display their league Coach credential. If you do not present it, you will be fined \$25.
- 56. Player who is injured on the field, his Coach or assistant may not enter the field without the permission of the referee. You must ask permission to enter to assist your player.
- 57. Player who is injured and is helped by his Coach or assistant, said player will have to leave the field and return with the permission of the referee.
- 58. Players with mental retardation or disabilities, he or she may play a division younger than their age.
- 59. Players under the age of 18 playing on Adult Free division teams they are responsible for having one of their parents sign their registration form.
- 60. Player, Coach or cheerleader who hits a referee, will be punished for 2 years without participating in any league event and the responsible team will pay a \$100.00 fine.
- 61. A team that plays in the league and later, even if it announces that it will not appear in the other games, will pay fines. The affected teams, team or teams that lose against said team, will play a match to qualify who goes to the next round.
- 62. Adult team that shows up with less than 7 players loses by foul. Each team pays its share of the field and referee.
- 63. Teams of U-10 or older the minimum number of players is 7. The minimum for Div. U-9 or younger is 5 and the opposing team can have 2 more players on the field.
- 64. In case a team does not show up or a player does not want to play the game, they will lose by foul and they will pay the cost of field and referee for the 2 teams.
- 65. All games for the Youth Division are on Sundays. In case there is double day, if there is a place, they will all be in the fields of Sports Village. For the Free Division the matches are on Fridays @ 6:00 and 8:00 pm.
- 66. Junior Division matches are on Sundays. Team that changes or cancels its game, must pay the cost of use of the field of the Sunday that cancels or changes. Y will pay for the field for the 2 teams if they play it during the week, and if the opposing team accepts the change.
- 67. Team that cancels or changes its match and the opposing team agrees, has 2 weeks to play that pending game or lose the game by foul. The game in 2 hours.
